





Causes of Hidden Economy

- Tax and Social Security Burden
 - Not only size matters
 - Compliance costs (private and public)
- Regulation
 - Goods quality requirements
 - Price regulations and entry barriers
- Institutional Context



Effects

The Economy and Government Policies

- Positive incomes are being spent into the official economy
- Yet the gray sector has a negative effect on the tax system
- Might have short term stabilizing function, but in the long-term, can have lasting negative consequences for the institutional legitimacy
- Government policies are becoming more ineffective underfunding of public goods

Institutional Efficiency – level of fair competition

- Inflow of dirty money into politics
- Aids corruption and the criminalization of the economy
- Hinders efficient resource allocation

Business Efficiency

- Lack of enforcement of contractual obligations
- Increased regulatory burden on legitimate businesses



CSD Hidden Economy Index

Size of the hidden economy

 Subjective perceptions of businesses for the scope of the hidden economy in the country in general and in their respective sector

Hidden employment

- Hiring workers without contract
- Underreported remuneration (envelope wages)

Hidden turnover


- Failure to issue tax receipts on sales
- Underreporting turnover
- Underreporting profit
- Illegal (undeclared) export / import

Hidden redistribution

- Evasion / nonpayment of taxes, fees, customs, excise duties
- VAT fraud




Dynamics of The Hidden Economy Index, 2002 - 2013 (Business)

Assessment of the Report Capacities of Regulatory Agencies

- National Revenue Agency (NRA)
- Chief Labor Inspectorate (CLI)
- Bulgarian Food Safety Agency (BFSA)
- Executive Forest Agency (EFA)
- National Construction Control Department (NCCD)
- Bulgarian Drug Agency
- Regional Health Inspectorates
- Regional Inspectorates on the Environment




Report Capacities of the Regulatory Agencies

- Not all regulatory agencies have built up adequate basic public accountability mechanisms, such as publishing an annual activity report
- None of the agencies provide a comprehensive efficiency and impact analysis of its work
- NRA started reporting on some impact indicators
- Certain elements need to be present in order for visibility and quality control to be assured. Some of these elements include:
 - details about staff, budget, type of governance;
 - watchdog function
 - the service of information center, including fraud signals by citizens;
 - actions taken as a result of citizens' signals and complaints;
 - report on auditing revisions and results of specific regulatory actions.



Measures Proposed in 2008 and 2009 to Limit the Hidden Economy





Policy Actions on Hidden Economy - Recommendations

- indicators across government regulatory agencies
- tackling corruption through the introduction of e-services in administration
- speeding-up VAT refunds and reducing control checks on law-abiding companies
- administrative reform to speed-up payments on European programs
- better legal framework on late payments and business-to-business private debt
- special focus on improving legislature in terms of filing for bankruptcy in a retroactive manner
- promoting free enterprise and competition through improving the enforcement of the anti-monopoly legislation.
