

Facilitating Role




Facilitating Role

- Serving a need to the drugs criminals; money to the right person, at the right place and on time
- Hawala bankers provide peace and stability
- Human smuggling; functioning as notary; guarantee smooth and safe deal


Facilitating Role

- Transfer of proceeds of crime to e.g. Dubai, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan
- Investment in the Netherlands e.g. in Smart phone business, wedding halls; concealing the origin of money (laundering money)

The basic structure




Advanced structure


