Inter-disciplinarity is part of the evaluation criteria (Excellence)

Social sciences and humanities research will be fully integrated into each of the priorities of Horizon 2020 and each of the specific objectives and will contribute to the evidence base for policy making at international, Union, national, regional and local level.[...] The specific objective of the societal challenge 'Europe in a changing world - Inclusive, innovative and reflective societies' will support social sciences and humanities research by focusing on inclusive, innovative and reflective societies. (H2020 Regulation of Establishment)

FP 7 Project: Anticorruption Policies Revisited: Global Trends and European Responses to the Challenge of Corruption

ANTICORRP is a large-scale research project funded by the European Commission's Seventh Framework Programme. The project started in March 2012 and will end in February 2017.

The project will identify general global trends concerning corruption and select 'over-performing' and 'under-performing' countries (in Europe and in other regions) in terms of their progress towards less corrupt governance regimes and conduct more detailed qualitative analyses of these cases.
