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#### **Elections**

- OSCE/ODIHR and EC Report:
  - "The elections were held in a competitive environment and fundamental freedoms were generally respected"
- However...
  - Professional capacity of election administration inadequate;
  - No political follow-up to the abuse of public funds for election purposes;
  - Media did not exercise editorial independence;
  - High public distrust in outcome.
- Need for professional and impartial election administration.







### **Anti-Corruption**

- Anti-Corruption Agency
  - Conflict of interest
  - Lobbying
  - Integrity
  - Whistleblowers protection
  - Political finance
- Noticed shortcomings:
  - Lack of capacity
  - Lack of proactive approach
  - Lack of transparency and opennes
  - Credibility issues







## **Judiciary**

- Progress made:
  - New legislative framework
  - Increased capacities of Judicial and Prosecutorial Councils
  - Increased transparency
  - First "big fish" corruption cases
- What is missing...
  - Independence (recruitment and promotion)
  - Accountability (Code of Ethics and disciplinary proceedings)
  - Capacity building







### **Public Administration Reform**

- 2016-2020 Public Administration Reform Strategy
  - De-politicization
  - Right-Sizing
  - Improve RIA
  - Merit-based recruitment
  - Policy Planing and Coordination







### Role of CSOs

- Important roles:
  - Monitoring
  - Watchdog
  - Policy Advocacy
- EU support:
  - Regional exchanges and networking
  - Access to infiormation and knowledge
