Alenka Prvinsek is a senior policy advisor and legal expert in the area of citizenship, asylum, integration, civil status and migration policy at the International Centre for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD). As of 2007 Ms. Prvinsek has been responsible for monitoring and developing EU legal standards with regard to migration. She has vast experience in all aspects of legal migration and provides legal expertise with regard to sustainable solutions related to the integration of minority groups and enhancement of migration management in developing countries and countries in transition.

Since 1980 onward she dealt with civil status, nationality and migration in the Slovenian Government, ending her career in Slovenia in 2004, after accession to the EU, as State Undersecretary responsible for implementation and harmonization of the migration Acquis (from 2001-2004). Ms. Prvinsek's international activities include cooperation with the Council of Europe, serving as Chair of the Working Group of experts on nationality for drafting the Convention on Avoidance of Statelessness in relation to state succession, Vice Chair of Committee of experts on nationality and cooperation with UNHCR. Ms. Prvinsek is a graduate of the Edvard Kardelj University's Law Faculty in Ljubljana.
